PASSPORTS: Exhibitors must ensure that passports are brought with each horse/pony in their care.

PLEASE NOTE: In all ridden Classes, horses and ponies must be four years old or over, and mare or gelding, unless otherwise stated. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday before 1st January 2022. Should a rider fall off in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring dismounted and take no further part in that class. Handlers under the age of 14 are not permitted to show colts or stallions born before 1st January 2022.

HATS, RIDING - Anyone riding a pony/horse at any show must wear a riding hat. In all classes it is strongly recommended that competitors over the age 16 wear skull caps or riding hats in accordance with the current approved BSI or European standard. It is mandatory for competitors up to and including the age of 16 to wear a correctly secured riding hat to the current approved BSI or European standard. In Hand, it is mandatory for competitors up to and including the age of 16 to wear a correctly secured riding hat to the current approved BSI or European standard.

SPURS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED IN ANY SHOW RING.

ALSO: The substitution of catalogued entries after the closing date will not be permitted, and no refunds will be given.

Unless otherwise stated all classes are restricted to mares & geldings, 4years and over

PLEASE NOTE: Entries close 31st August 2022. Exhibitor's numbers will be available from the Secretary after 8.30am on Show Day.

Subscriptions of £15 or over for 2 admission tickets and a car pass. One admission ticket per exhibitor for £6 or more of entry fees. To receive tickets, a stamped self-addressed envelope must be enclosed with entry.

H1. BEST TURNED OUT PONY, rider not to have attained their 16th birthday on show day.

LOCAL RIDING CLASS

Judging to follow Class H1. Rosettes for all competitors

H2. PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 147cm (14-2hh), RIDDEN BY CHILDREN 16YEARS AND UNDER on show day, restricted to owners, riders and ponies who live within an 15 mile radius of Bowes. To be judged 50% rider and turnout, 50% pony.

The A E Alderson Garage Services Perpetual Challenge Cup (1), kindly donated by P Alderson, will be held by the winner for one year.

CHILD'S FIRST PONY OF PONY CLUB/ HUNTER TYPE

Judging to follow H2. - Rosettes for all competitors

PLEASE NOTE: a child and/or pony combination can only enter ONE class H3-H5

H3. PONY 127CM (12-2hh) AND UNDER most suitable as child's first pony, to be judged at least 50% on manners, to be ridden by a child born in or after 2019. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached by the noseband only.

H4. PONY 127CM (12-2hh) AND UNDER most suitable as child's first pony, to be judged at least 50% on manners, to be ridden by a child born in or after 2011. To be shown in a snaffle bridle and NO LEAD REINS.

H5. PONY EXCEEDING 127CM (12-2hh) AND UNDER 147CM (14-2hh) most suitable as child's first pony, to be judged at least 50% on manners, to be ridden by a child born in or after 2006. To be shown in a snaffle bridle, NO LEAD REINS.

CHAMPIONSHIP: 1ST and 2nd prize winners from classes H3, H4 and H5, to be judged for the **J. D. Dowson Memorial Challenge Cup (3)**, to be held by the winner for one year.

H6 (A) FAMILY HORSE OF RIDING CLUB HUNTER TYPE, EXCEEDING 147CM (14-2hh) suitable to be ridden by any member of the family, to be shown in a snaffle bridle, to be judged at least 50% on manners and temperament. Rider any age. The Judge will NOT ride. The winner to hold the **Tranter Challenge Cup (37)** for one year only. Rosettes for all entries

H6(B) RIDING CLUB HORSE, EXCEEDING 147CM (14-2hh) suitable to compete at all riding club activities especially dressage, show jumping and cross country. Horses may be asked to jump a small jump (maximum height 65cm)

CHILDREN'S RIDING CLASSES

H7. LEAD REIN BEST RIDER, riders not to have attained 8th birthday before 1st January 2022. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached by the noseband only

All Equitation classes will be judged on riding ability alone and competitors will NOT be required to jump, but may be required to ride without stirrups according to the judge's requirements.

H8. RIDERS NOT ATTAINED 11TH BIRTHDAY before 1st January 2022. Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 147cm (14-2hh).

H9. RIDERS 11 TO 15 YEARS on 1st January 2022. Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, any height.

H10. RIDERS 16 YEARS TO 18 YEARS on 1st January 2022. Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, any height.

CHAMPIONSHIP: 1ST and 2nd prize winners from classes H7, H8, H9 and H10 to be judged for the **A.E.Alderson Perpetual Trophy (2)**, to be held by the winner for one year only.

H11 FANCY DRESS COMPETITION- open to all ages, ridden and in hand. Rosettes for all competitors.

All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS 2021 Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification. Only fully qualified Members holding a current VHS membership card and a VHS showing card with a valid qualification signature may enter. Both cards must be carried in the ring and produced on request – no exceptions will be made.

VHS Supreme Final qualification. Competitors placed 1st and 2nd in each class will qualify for the corresponding class at the VHS Supreme Final, to be held at the National Veteran Championships, Arena UK, Lincolnshire. Date TBC
If the competitor has already qualified or does not wish to attend, they must refuse the qualification and pass it down the line on the day. Hand your show card to the judge for signing.

VHS M&M Supreme Final qualification. Only given at the judges discretion. The highest placed M&M in each class will qualify for the VHS M&M Supreme Final at the National Veteran Championships. Registered Breeds only.

CLASS 2 VETERAN IN-HAND (20–24 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed registered M&M to qualify forward to the M&M Supreme Final - at the judges discretion.

CLASS 3 PRE-VETERAN IN-HAND (15–19 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed registered M&M to qualify forward to the M&M Supreme Final - at the judges discretion.

CLASS 4 DIAMOND VETERAN RIDDEN (25 years and over). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed registered M&M to qualify forward to the M&M Supreme Final - at the judges discretion.

CLASS 5 VETERAN RIDDEN (20–24 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed registered M&M to qualify forward to the M&M Supreme Final - at the judges discretion.

CLASS 6 PRE-VETERAN RIDDEN (15–19 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. Highest placed registered M&M to qualify forward to the M&M Supreme Final - at the judges discretion.
