VACCINATED HORSES ONLY. UNVACCINATED HORSES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOWFIELD

Entries are online only and will open on 1st June 2026 and close on 31st July 2026.

No late entries will be accepted under any circumstances.

Judges:

Judges will be announced via the Bowes Show Facebook Page from 1st June 2026 and will also be published on Horse Events from the same date.

General Rules & Conditions:

- All children entering classes must be accompanied by an adult.
- All riders must wear correct and current safety gear at all times.
- All horses entering the showground must have a valid passport and be microchipped.
- No animal suffering from a contagious disease may be brought onto the showground. The veterinary surgeon reserves the right to remove any such animal.
- Stallions must be handled or ridden by a competent person aged 14 years or over.
- Judges and organisers reserve the right to refuse entry on the grounds of unsoundness (including lameness, coughing) or dangerous behaviour.

Complaints Procedure:

- Complaints must be made on the day within 30 minutes of the incident.
- A £20 fee is required and will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.

Additional Regulations:

- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- No liability is accepted by organisers for any accident, loss, damage, injury, or illness.
- Entry implies acceptance of all rules and conditions.
